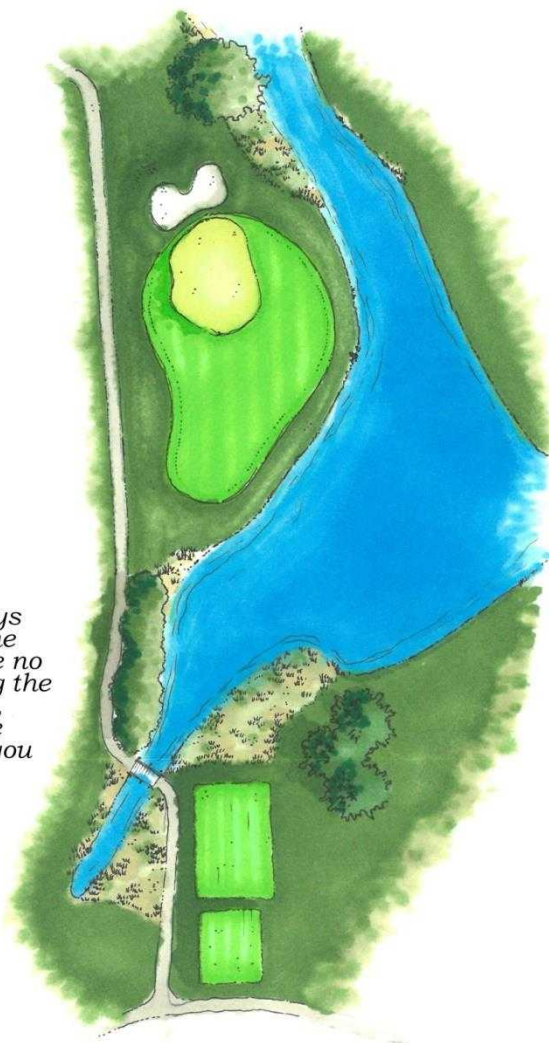






Hole 1

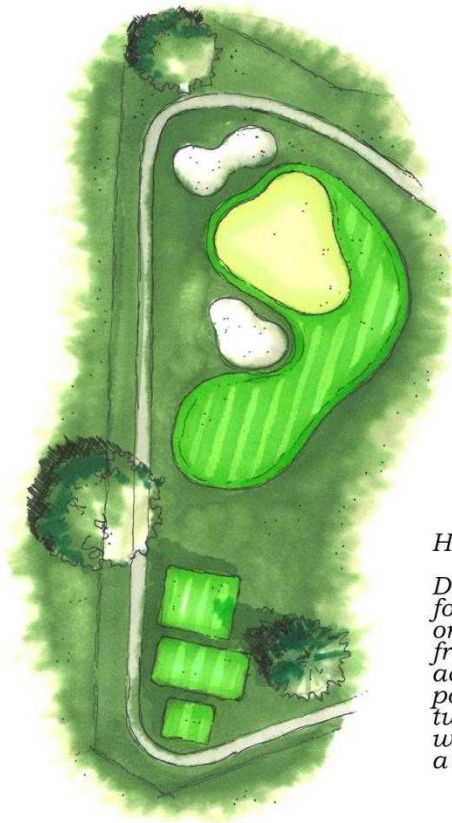
The first hole plays over a finger of the lake but there are no bunkers guarding the front of the green, allowing for some room to miss as you get started in the round.





Hole 2

*A pond and bunkers
both left and right set
up a challenging tee
shot on this 151-yard
second hole.*



Hole 3

Don't let the distance fool you. The third hole only plays to 100 yards from the back tee, but access to the left pin position is guarded by two bunkers. This hole will likely prove to put up a real challenge.



Hole 4

While only slightly longer than the previous hole, this par-3 is open to the tee leaving easy access to the golfer who has control over distance and direction from the tee. A bailout area in back provides additional relief for those who miss long.



Hole 5

Playing to 132-yards from the back tee, this hole plays fairly straightforward. The front pin position is easy to access with a bump-and-run but the back-left pin is best found with a high and soft right-to-left approach.



Hole 6

With trees guarding the tee shot both left and right, this 172-yard hole is set up to provide perhaps the toughest challenge on the course. Play for the middle of the green to avoid getting caught up in the trees or the greenside bunker.



Hole 7

A pins set on the right side of the green will prove to be a challenge as a tree guards the right side of the hole short of the green. Plenty of fairway area provides ample bailout for those who mishit from the tee.



Hole 8

This hole should provide everyone with their best shot at a birdie. Playing to 256-yards, the fairway is open to the tee shot. Just watch for the lake near the green as it will catch the sliced tee shot.

Hole 9

At 335-yards, the finishing hole is the longest on the course. Play a controlled tee shot to the fairway to avoid the lake skirting the right side of the hole, then muster up your straightest approach shot to avoid twin bunkers guarding the green both left and right.





Practice Range

The range mimics a large fairway and will provide an excellent area to practice all levels of your game.



Putting Green - Putting Course

A putting/ chipping area behind the practice range allows for short game practice before your round. Also, an 18-hole putting course challenges and entertains any who are short on time but are looking for some golfing fun.
